F.I.H. would like to inform you of upcoming changes that will become effective January 2019 per our Foster Care Contract in reference to monthly clothing order allowance and the child base allowance appropriate to age are as follows.

ALLOWANCE

5-7 yrs	\$7.00
8-10 yrs	\$10.00
11-13 yrs.	\$13.00
14-15 yrs,	\$15.00
16-17 yrs.	\$18.00
18-20 yrs.	\$ 25.00

Recourse families are also expected to provide a minimum monthly clothing allowance of \$70.00 per child.

Foster homes must remain in compliance with such requirements as CPR/First Aid, yearly training hours and required documents for placement of foster children. Futuro has 2 new programs: Whole Foster Family Home (WFFH) and Emergency Shelter Care (ESC). If you are interested in either program contact Lily Olan at (626) 339-1824.

- Whole Foster Family Home (WFFH) is a foster home/resource home that can care for a teen parent with a child upon successful completion of the specified training.
- Emergency Shelter Care (ESC) is a foster home/resource home that can provide 24-hour care for a child/youth temporarily for up to 21 days if approved by DCFS once the agency submits your application and documents. This program includes a stipend on top of your days of care rate whether or not the foster child is in your home.
