Do Car Seats Expire? Yes, car seats do expire. In fact, most car seats have an expiration date on one of the [manufacturer labels](#) that can be found on the sides or bottom of the car seat. To find out if a car seat is expired, you should look for that expiration date label first. If there's no expiration date listed, use the date of manufacture and consult the car seat owners' manual. Many manufacturers give a maximum car seat life in the manual. If not, call the manufacturer and ask.

The rule of thumb, if no expiration date is given on the seat, is that car seats expire **six** years from the date of manufacture. A few car seat manufacturers allow up to 10 years of life for their car seats, but unless you have specific directions from the manufacturer, the car seat label or the manual that state otherwise, you should stop using a car seat after **6** years. Expired car seats should be destroyed so that no one picks the seat up thinking that it is still safe to use. Good ways to destroy car seats include cutting up the cover, cutting the harness straps.

Where can I get my fire extinguisher serviced?

The fire extinguishers need to be serviced once a year or a new purchased and receipt submitted for your records. All fire extinguishers need to have a tag dated with the last time it was serviced. To find a fire extinguisher service center near you, look in your yellow pages or internet. Social Worker will be looking for the expiration tag on all extinguishers. If extinguishers are new, social worker will be asking for the receipt.

AMENDMENT I

Personal Rights Key Points

*The foster child must be involved in the selection of clothing based on the developmental level of the child.

*Foster Parents are expected to always be in compliance with the following requirements:

- (1) supply each foster child, initially and replace as needed, with new personal hygiene and personal care items which include: own toothbrush, toothpaste, comb and other hair-care items, shampoo, soap, deodorant, sanitary napkins, etc.;
- (2) offer choice among brands as long as the cost is reasonable;
- (3) give consideration to specific cultural and ethnic needs;
- (4) provide specific brands necessary for health reasons; and
- (5) monitor the use of all products in aerosol or glass containers.

*Car seat safety regulations effective 1/1/2012 states that newborns to at least 1 year of age and at least 20 pounds must be in rear-facing car seat.

*Emergency Protocol includes the emergency services (clinical intervention and/or call to P.E.T.) by professional staff (social workers, supervisors, and/or Licensed Clinical Social Worker) for the support and guidance to foster parents including additional training recommended and for the professional staff to assess the mental health status of the foster child to rule out any threat or harm to themselves or others.

ENMIENDA 1

Puntos clave sobre derechos personales

*El niño de crianza debe participar en la selección de su ropa basándose en el nivel de desarrollo del niño.

* Los padres de crianza deberán cumplir siempre con los siguientes requerimientos:

- (1) proveer a cada niño de crianza inicialmente y reemplazar según sea necesario, artículos de higiene y cuidado personal nuevos que incluyan: cepillo de dientes propio, pasta de dientes, peine y otros artículos de cuidado del cabello, champú, jabón, desodorante, toallas sanitarias, etc.;
- (2) ofrecer la opción de diferentes marcas siempre y cuando el costo sea razonable;
- (3) considerar las diferentes necesidades culturales y étnicas específicas;
- (4) proveer marcas específicas necesarias por razones de salud; y
- (5) supervisar el uso de todos los productos en recipientes de vidrio o aerosol.

* Las regulaciones sobre sillas de seguridad del carro efectivas desde 01/01/2012 especifican que los recién nacidos y niños de por lo menos 1 año de edad y por lo menos 20 libras deben estar en la silla de seguridad mirando hacia atrás.

* El protocolo de emergencia incluye los servicios de emergencia (intervención clínica o llamada al P.E.T.) por profesionales (trabajadores sociales, supervisores o Trabajador Social Clínico Licenciado) para apoyar y orientar a los padres de crianza incluyendo la capacitación adicional que sea recomendada y para que el personal profesional evalúe el estado de salud mental del niño de crianza y poder descartar cualquier amenaza o daño a sí mismos o a otros.

Personal Rights Key Points For Foster Parents

*Foster parents must include foster children (over 10 years old) in selecting and buying their clothing.
