## Where can I get my fire extinguisher serviced?

The fire extinguishers need to be serviced once a year or a new one must be purchased and the receipt for it submitted for your records. All fire extinguishers need to have a tag dated with the last time it was serviced. To find a fire extinguisher service center near you, look in your yellow pages or internet. The social worker visiting your home will look for the expiration tag on all extinguishers every year. If extinguishers are new the social worker will ask for the receipt.

### **WHAT IS THE CONTINUUM OF CARE REFORM (CCR)**

Continuum of Care Reform, or AB403, authorized by Assembly Bill 403 (Chapter 773, Statues of 2015) is a comprehensive reform of the foster care system that is the culmination of years of effort. Through the engagement of a broad range of stakeholders (youth, parents, probation, tribes, mental health, and others), this law was signed in October 2015 and is being implemented to ensure that foster youth have the opportunity to grow up in permanent supportive homes and to become self-sufficient, successful adult.

### **QUE ES LA REFORMA DE CUIDADO CONTINUADO (CCR)**

Reforma de cuidado Continuada, o AB403, autorizado por la Asamblea cuenta 403(Capitulo 773, estatutos del 2015) es una reforma exhaustiva del sistema de cuidad de crianza que es la culminación de años de esfuerzo. A través del compromiso de un amplio arreglo de los grupos interesados (Jóvenes, padres, probación, tribus, salud mental, y otros) esta ley fue firmada en Octubre 2015 y esta siendo implementada para asegurar que los jóvenes en cuidado de crianza tengan la oportunidad de crecer en un hogar de apoyo permanente y que se conviertan en adultos auto suficientes y exitosos.

### **RESOURCE FAMILY APPROVAL (RFA)**

An essential component of CCR is the Resource Family Approval program, whose goals is the implementation of a streamlined, unified family-friendly approach to developing home based placements for children in the Child Welfare and probation systems. All new resource families in California will participate in RFA effective January 1, 2017.

### **APROBACION DE FAMILIAS DE RECURSOS (RFA)**

Un componente esencial de la Reforma de Cuidado Continuada (CCR) es el Programa de Aprobación para Familias de Recursos cuya meta es la implementación de un eficiente, unificado y amigable acercamiento de familias para desarrollar colocaciones en hogares de niños que están en el sistema de bienestar social y probación. Todas las familias de recursos nuevas de California participaran en la Aprobación de Familias de Recursos comenzando Enero 1, 2017.
