Trauma/Resilience Tip of the Week: Integrated Core Practice Model

The Integrated Core Practice Model (ICPM) is a framework that provides practical guidance and direction for systems (i.e. Department of Mental Health, Department of Children and Family Services, and Probation) that serve children and families involved with Child Welfare and/or Probation. The ICPM is intended to reduce risks and barriers through collaboration and integration across systems; and serve children and families utilizing shared values, core components, and standards of practice. The ICPM framework endeavors to prevent redundancy of services and re-traumatization by providing uniform messages through an integrated process.
